(1) List your judicial experience (courts & years).

Elected to the Franklin County Municipal Court in 2007 general election to an unexpired term, and elected to a full term in 2009 general election.

(2) What about your non-judicial legal experience qualifies you to be a judge?

I was a sole practitioner for 25 years before being elected in 2007. I practiced in all Ohio Courts during that time, in many counties, including municipal courts, common pleas courts, domestic relations courts, juvenile courts, and federal courts.
