(1) List your judicial experience (courts & years).

Since 1992 I have been in private practice and have served as Steubenville Prosecutor the last ten. I have practiced in Steubenville Municipal Court, Jefferson County Court (3), Jefferson County Common Pleas Court, Jefferson Count Prabate and Juvenile Court, and the Seventh District Court of Appeals. I have also practiced in courts in Belmont, Harrison and Tuscarawas Counties. I have handled over 1,000 cases at the Common Pleas Court level and have prosecuted over 10,000 cases. I have argued numerous cases on appeal and have had some of my cases published. I was at one time death penalty certified by the Ohio Supreme Court.

(2) What about your non-judicial legal experience qualifies you to be a judge?

Since 1992 I have personally tried numerous criminal and civil cases including murder. i have practiced in the Steubenville Municipal Court as prosecutor the last ten years and am very familiar with the challenges that face that court. I have a very good working relationship with the Bar, judges and public boards for whom I serve. I have twice been the winner of the Steubenville Herald Star Readers choice award for best divorce attorney (2007 and 2013) and have been nominated every year since 2007.
