I have served as a judge in the Delaware Municipal Court since February 2015.

(2) What about your non-judicial legal experience qualifies you to be a judge?

I am proud to have an exemplary record over the last 17 years as a prosecutor in municipal, common pleas, and appellate courts including the Ohio Supreme Court. Fourteen of the past years I spent prosecuting cases in each court in Delaware County. As a special prosecutor for the Ohio Attorney General's Office I represented the State of Ohio in 23 counties, including working as lead prosecutor on the much-covered Steubenville rape trial. My experience includes cases spanning the breadth and depths of our legal system from the most serious possible offense—murder with a death penalty specification—to low level traffic offenses. Additionally, I have conducted seminars covering a broad array of legal issues in the criminal law for professionals from a wide range of disciplines and fields including legal, medical, scientific, and law enforcement to name a representative sampling. For my work, I have received a number of awards. The highest form of recognition, however, comes from the simple thank-you notes written by families of victims and survivors who have suffered immeasurable horrors at the hands of criminal defendants who were convicted of their crimes in trials in which I served as the prosecuting attorney. These people bring true reality to the crime and into the courtrooms where I have practiced throughout my career. These interactions and experiences will, and have, tempered me as a judge and will ensure justice is served.

(3) Why are you running for this particular court seat?

My extensive legal and courtroom experience, legal background, work ethic, personality and temperament make me the best candidate for the Delaware Municipal Court where I can continue my service to the citizens of Delaware County. The cases heard by a municipal court judge are matters in which I have extensive trial experience, a keen awareness of how these matters impact a community and a personal drive to address and resolve these kinds of matters within our legal system. I am a candidate for this position because the pace of the Delaware Municipal Court suits me and the interest I have in continuing my professional participation in our legal system.
