

Book Review











On April 17, we met at Laurel Winters' home for our April meeting. Kirklyn Kuzdrall gave an interesting review of the book *Horse* by Pultizer-Prize winning author Geraldine Brooks. It tells the story of Lexington, a record-breaking thoroughbred and the people who owned, cared for, and raced this horse in the mid-1800s. In addition, art, science, and racism were also part of the story. Although the book was fictional, every owner in the book was a real person.

Kirklyn brought her own resource person, friend Rachel, who is a horsewoman and owns two thor-oughbreds. She offered information about breeds, the nature of horses, and horse racing today.




