That is true for both the University Council and for the OSGA. So, if you're thinking about it, do it.

John Messina: I just want to make a comment. The role of students on both University Council and Faculty Senate is traditional. There are some administrators who may or may not have a lot of interaction with students that will look to you to provide opinions on any number of things, and also, in many cases, the presidents always report out at the meetings, but we have other representatives that individuals will come to you, ask questions, and listen to your opinions, so I want to emphasize that there are several committees that are apart of UC that we really would like the student voice on. People really do listen; they're not just a person just sitting in the background.

Senate Chair Feezel: We will move forward to nominations for this position. Anyone in USG can nominate anyone for this. You have to be available Tuesdays from 3-4:30. They're once a month. So are there any nominations?

President DeWitt: I would like to nominate Chief of Staff Lane.

Senate Chair Feezel: Do you accept?

Chief of Staff Lane: Yes.
