

USG FINANCIAL REVIEW


Undergraduate Student Government has the privilege of managing funds that sponsor travel and projects for the more than 300 student organizations on The University of Akron's Campus. Student organizations can submit a request for funding through Presence.

USG Funding to Student Orgs

This semester, USG has allocated **\$20,959.32** for student organization travel and **\$16,370.10** towards student organization projects and events.

There are two accounts that funds can be distributed from when student organizations are requesting funding:

1. **UAF Account:** used for approving allocations for student organizations for travel requests and projects/events.
2. **Platform Account:** used to support a specific purpose that USG is promoting, allocated to student organizations and relevant to the pillars of the platform. This is open to all events/students that are eligible for sponsorship and must adhere to the values of the pillars set in the platform.

USG Budget

USG also has an internal budget to fund projects, events, and initiatives, as well as cover other internal expenses.

This semester, USG allocated **\$13,302.52** internally.

There are three accounts that can be used to distribute the USG Budget:

1. **President's Account:** used for USG projects and events, elections, marketing, and membership development expenses.
2. **SAF Account:** used for materials and supplies needed for the annual OSGS conference.
3. **Admin Account:** used for office supplies only, including the annual office wall placard, which is changed with every new presidency.



EXECUTIVE BRANCH

The Executive Branch consists of appointed members, as well as the President and Vice President who are elected by the undergraduate student body. Members of the Executive Branch work to carry out the USG Platform. Appointed members of USG include a variety of roles that focus on areas such as:

- Project and Event Facilitation
- Finance and Budget Review
- Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion
- Community and Campus Engagement
- Membership Development
- Image and Marketing

All Executive Branch members play a vital role in USG’s mission and activities throughout the academic year! Additionally, the Executive Branch facilitates three committees: **Campus Dining Experience Committee**, **Mental Health Task Force**, and **Diversity Committee**. These committees, whose membership includes both USG and non-USG members, facilitate projects and events that align with their mission.

The Unify UAkron Platform

During their time in Undergraduate Student Government, President Grace DeWitt and Vice President Elena Kozma have been focused on advocating for the student body and supporting positive change at UA. It is their belief that working with administration, faculty, and staff on behalf of students helps ensure the university is offering the best experience for students. The Unify UAkron Platform was created as a framework for USG members to follow in their pursuits of their projects, initiatives, and events. Through these efforts, Undergraduate Student Government can help the university flourish to its full potential.

The pillars of the Unify UAkron Platform are:

Academic Development

- Strengthening the relationship between students and the colleges

Professional Development

- Supporting student groups on campus (student orgs, athletics, greek life)

Community Development


- Working to build community among students

JUDICIAL BRANCH

The Judicial Branch consists of an appointed panel of Justices headed by the Executive Justice and the Chief Justice.

Justices interpret and revise governing documents, review student organizational grievances, run both Fall and Spring USG elections and election events, maintain USG record-keeping, and work towards general advocacy to benefit the student body at The University of Akron.

Department of Student Conduct and Community Standards

In the past few years, the Judicial Branch has undergone many changes in regard to their responsibilities to advocate for the student body. This year, the Judicial Branch worked heavily alongside the Department of Student Conduct and Community Standards to provide a students perspective on many of their proceedings.

Their members volunteered to speak at the Department's presentations in the freshman Akron Experience Courses, reaching most of the incoming student body. The Branch collaborated with the Department at the Rootbeer Kegger during Alcohol Awareness week, providing the student body with on and off campus resources. Each member of the Judicial Branch is a trained member of The University of Akron's Hearing Board.

Fall 2024 Election Cycle

During elections season, the Judicial Branch transforms into the Elections Board, the governing body that oversees the USG elections process, election materials, and voting verification. The Elections Board ensures a fair and friendly competition that aims to provide the best representative for the study body.

The 2024 Fall Election Cycle witnessed an approximately 9% rise in voter turnout compared to last year's Fall Election Cycles.

Spring 2025 Election Cycle

The Elections Board has already begun work on the Spring Election Cycle. They aim to expand their marketing efforts for this Election Cycle, incorporating interviews and additional tabling events.

LEGISLATIVE BRANCH



Fall 2024 Senate Meetings

The Legislative Branch consists of numerous elected members, including:

- Senate Chair
- Vice Senate Chair
- Senators At-Large (7)
- College-Specific Senators (5)
- Off-Campus Living Senator
- First-Year Senators (2)
- Senate Clerk

Senators pursue projects and write legislation that serves to benefit the undergraduate student body. They work in committees and within their represented demographic to turn ideas into reality to benefit the University of Akron students. Additionally, senate leadership congratulates newly established student organizations and provides them with critical insight about funding and resources.

Legislative Branch Committees

Academic Policy and Student Success (APSS)

APSS aims to establish connections between students, staff, and administration. Members work to distribute academic and financial information as well as promote and advocate for the student experience.

This semester, APSS has pursued...

- Working on instituting reading days
- Planning a de-stress event close to finals week
- Tabling to encourage students to fill out course evaluations

Student Engagement (SE)

SE's purpose is to create a campus environment that builds community and enhances the experience of undergraduates by working with student organizations.

This semester, SE has pursued...

- A Starship Delivery robots Survey intended to gauge student utilization of the service
- Partnered with Health and Safety Officer Ruffin to institute campus safety walks

Facilities, Amenities, Services and Transportation (FAST)

FAST looks to advocate for the safety of students and enhance the on-campus student experience through housing, parking, transportation, and various other services on campus.

This semester, FAST has pursued...

- Accessibility Tours in 12 out of 25 academic buildings on campus
- Grant writing in partnership with Lights Out Akron to get the Goodyear Building modified to decrease bird deaths
- The Akron Zoo found that the Building has accounted for over half of the bird deaths in the Akron area.

Currently, all of the Senate committees are working together on drafting legislation pertaining to unauthorized vehicles that drive on campus walkways. They are trying to figure out whether or not this legislation would be feasible.

USG put on a variety of events throughout the Fall 2024 semester. Each event had a different focus such as: getting to know what's happening in the community, mental health awareness, and simply having a fun break from responsibilities. Some of these events included...

- **UAPD Meet and Greet** - Students got to know UAPD officers and the services that they provide
- **Bridging Campus and Community** - Worked towards building a closer relationship between the city of Akron and the university as well as to help students feel more connected to their local government.
- **International Lounge Dedication** - Highlighted the work done to the International Lounge done in an effort to make international students feel at home and recognized at the University of Akron.
- **Pumpkin Positivity Painting** - Helped students destress and ease their minds by painting pumpkins...because it was *spooky* season.
- **Akron Art Museum** - Collaboration between USG, GSG, Myers School of Art, and the Akron Art Museum to bring students to the art museum downtown for the new GLOW Exhibit connecting campus and community

The deadline to submit the Event Planning Request form is 3 weeks ahead of the events date.


If this form is submitted after that deadline, there is no guarantee that the Events Team will be able to help with your event. *You can access this form in the USG Teams and the USG office.*


