
Rationale for SENATE RESOLUTION 06-25-26

All,

The Undergraduate Student Government serves as the voice and governing body for the undergraduate student community at the University of Akron. Through constituent outreach and personal observations, it has come to our attention that the University of Akron's Student Recreation and Wellness Center (SRWC) contains an outdated water fountain on the first-floor entrance that no longer meets the needs of the SRWC users.

This water fountain does not include a water bottle filling station, and its inadequate water pressure makes it nearly unusable for students. As a result, students seeking hydration methods in the SWRC must enter the athletic portion of the recreational center. This not only creates an unnecessary barrier in terms of water obtainment for those who visit the clinics on the first floor of the SRWC, but this undermines the accessibility and convenience that the SRWC is intended to provide to the student body and the University of Akron community.

Access to clean, functional, and easily refillable water stations is essential to the university's mission of promoting student wellness and health. The presence of proper water stations in the SRWC encourages both sustainable practices and supports physical health. By upgrading this station, our collective student voice can take a step toward enhancing overall student experience.

Overall, we urge the University of Akron to recognize the importance of student well-being and recommend that the entry water fountain station in the SRWC be refurbished with proper water pressure and a bottle filling station so that students and other SRWC users can enjoy their physical fitness with the necessary resources.
