Legislative Branch (LB)

- On January 29th, our Athletics Director, Dr. Andrew Goodrich, spoke at the Senate Meeting about his goals as our new Athletic Director.
- On February 26th the Senate held their Mock Debate in which they enhanced their debating skills and their knowledge of parliamentary procedure.
- There are currently several initiatives which hopefully will appear on the senate floor soon, ranging from accessibility of menstrual products in restrooms, meal swipes at sporting events, expanding campus recreation, and more!
