Legislative Branch (LB)

- On March 5th, USG had the honor to have the Mayor of Akron, Shammias Malik speak at a Senate Meeting. There, he discussed his experience prior to becoming Mayor, and focused on advocacy for others and improving our community.
- On March 12th, Chief of Staff Kelly led the Senate in a LinkedIn Workshop
- Many Senator projects have been in the works this month, concerning meal swipes, dorm accessibility, facility security, outreach, and more!

Historical Records

- In March 2010, Associated Student Government passed SR 26-09-10 "Springboard Utilization" which dealt with low usage of Springboard, which is now Brightspace. This legislation covers the same issues that SR 08-25-26 "Brightspace Grade Reporting" that was written by Senator Sterns on March 5th!
- In March of last year, USG's Senate passed SR 02-24-25 "Pride Flag Installation", which instructed USG on the purchase and installation of a Pride Flag in the Student Union, to replace the flags that had been taken down earlier that year.

Judicial Branch (JB)

- As the Elections Board, the branch has been running the Spring election cycle! At the end of March, Senators for the 2026-2027 academic year were elected, and the President and Vice President will be elected at the beginning of April
- The branch tabled for the Department of Student Conduct in the Student Union for Sexual Assault Awareness Month
- The branch reviewed and amended the Grievance Process for constitutional and elections grievances
